Market-goers can enjoy shopping local producers, sampling foods, watching chef demos from RRB/ITC's culinary team, and dining al fresco for lunch on the Plaza.

Market partner, the [Capital Arts Collective \(CAC\)](#) returns for its 6th season beginning June 3. Joining the event on the first and third Wednesdays of each month, CAC features a rotating lineup of local artists and makers, bringing handcrafted goods and custom-designed items to the Plaza to enhance the experience and create a lively blend of art, flavor, and community all in one place.
